For future reference, if you decide to do planned improvements to your lot please be aware that a request must be sent to the GCW HOA Board. As a Board, we strive for an attractive, harmonious residential development having continuing appeal.

As the weather turns warmer, please keep in mind all GCW homeowners are responsible for maintenance and upkeep of their respective lot and the lot's landscaping, "...maintain in a good, orderly, neat and healthy condition, free from disease and pest infestation." Article VI, Section 2

Store your trash and recycling receptacles inside your garage or other enclosed areas. Leaving these receptacles outside is unsightly for our community and if continued could lead to pests, infestation and covenant violations.

Also, be aware of our rules under Article VII, which govern swimming pools and accessory structures, etc. Please read through those sections and inquire if you need clarification.

Lastly, be aware of the GCW covenants which clearly state the restrictions in regards to parking vehicles. Please refer to Article VII, Section 2 of our covenants, which state: "No inoperable, commercial or recreational vehicles of any type, including, without limitation boats, trailers, campers, motor homes...shall be parked or stored, temporarily or permanently, on any lot which is not fully enclosed."
